

RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES at IT Sligo – the 2012 President’s Bursary Awards

The bursary will have two elements:

1. A maintenance grant of €7,250 p.a.
2. Tuition fees (currently €2,319 p.a.) will be paid by the Institute for all holders of student bursaries. Students are required to pay their registration fee. The registration fee for 2011-2012 is €2,250 p.a.

There will also be an annual amount of €4k for consumables that may be drawn down for appropriate projects.

Postgraduate students funded under this scheme will be required to provide academic support for up to three hours per week.

Following selection, a candidate will undertake the process of application for entry to the postgraduate register, which involves academic appraisal of the candidate, the project, supervisory arrangements and other factors. This is an independent step and selection at interview as the preferred candidate does not guarantee approval at this second stage.
