<p>1. To review assessment with the view to increase weighting of continuous assessment and encourage implementation of a wider variety of assessment methods.</p>	<p>Weighting of continuous assessment was reviewed and programme board members felt that the mix was appropriate with practical subjects having a higher CA weighting, while more academic subjects such as accounting or law require a heavier emphasis on final exam, albeit with assessment throughout the semester. The balance of assessments across semesters seems fair to learners.</p>
<p>2. The panel recommends to actively build an Alumni group within the Department using existing links.</p>	<p>This is something which exists informally within this programme and would be considered on a departmental or school level. However, we will appraise developments at an institute level before embarking on a solo run.</p> <p>It is hoped to have a re-union of graduates of the entire school in late 2017</p>
