Apply for EI accreditation at the end of 2016/17, or start of 2017/18 academic years, following completion of the taught modules (Postgrad Dip) with a view to obtaining early accreditation for the programme.
4. That a graphic overview of the programme content, the module sequence and assessment schedule be incorporated in the submissions document.	Develop new course flyer with more detailed graphic of course progression and content.
