Dr. James Bonsall MIAI, is Chief Scientist on board the RV Celtic Voyager and project leader for The Irish Sea Palaeolandscapes Investigation Project which will be collecting sediment cores from Liverpool Bay and Cardigan Bay between 8th-13th November. The project will look for traces of the Mesolithic-Neolithic transition between Ireland and Britain with the cores then being assessed for Ancient Sedimentary DNA. A small touring exhibition of images and notes will be produced on the projects return and can be viewed at the locations above.

CARROWKEEL ARCHAEOLOGY WALK WITH SAM MOORE

Bus departs IT Sligo at 9.30am

The Carrowkeel passage tomb complex

constitutes one of the best preserved Neolithic funerary landscapes in Europe. It is situated in the Bricklieve Mountains, Co Sligo. The complex comprises 24 passage tombs and cairns that were likely constructed during the Middle Neolithic Ages (3500–2900 cal. BC). Sam will lead a walk in which you will visit four of the 24 cairns in the complex, and explore inside two of the cairns and visit Pollnagolum Cave and the view overlooking the Maullaghfarna Plateau. It is a relatively slow paced walk with many stops to both explore and rest. Sam Moore is an archaeologist with a keen interest in Irish passage tombs specifically and prehistory in general. He has written or contributed to a considerable number of local history articles, books and guides, and has considerable archaeological excavation and survey experience. 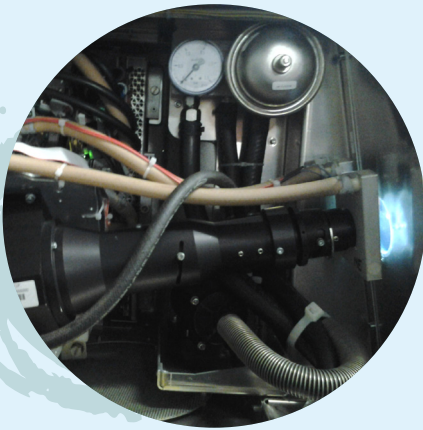

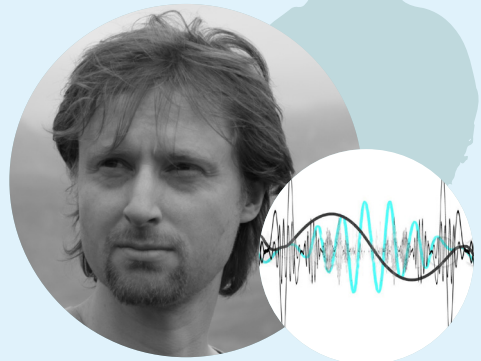

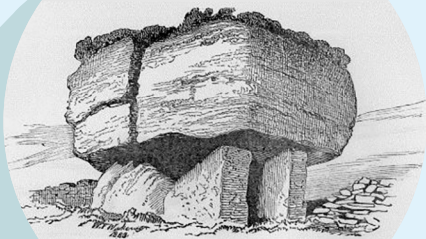
MOONWALKING IN SLIGO

William G. Wood-Martin's importance rests primarily on his valuable contributions to Irish antiquarian and historical research. His writings include *Lake Dwellings of Ireland*; *Pagan Ireland*; *Traces of the Elder Faiths of Ireland*; *The Rude Stone Monuments of Ireland, County Sligo and Achill Island*, and are well known to students of Irish archaeology and folklore to this day. His *Sligo and the Enniskilleners, 1688–1691*, published in 1880, was followed by his 3-volume *History of Sligo, County and Town*, published between 1882 and 1892, is widely regarded as a work of national as well as local importance. Wood-Martin died at Cleveragh House, Sligo, on 16th November 1917. Speakers from the disciplines of archaeology, folklore and history will contextualize his work and contributions 100 years after his death.

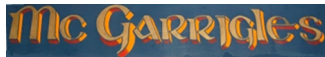
