

You may need to open a bank account in Ireland during your studies. This guide will help you to open an account with the AIB bank located on campus.

Banks on IT Sligo Campus

There is an AIB bank on IT Sligo campus. Please check the opening hours before visiting.

If the campus branch is closed, there is another AIB branch in Sligo town. This is a 15-minute walk from campus.

How do I open a bank account?

EU/EEC Students

- If you are a student from the EU/EEC, and aged 18+, you can open a bank account using the AIB Mobile Banking App. Further guidance is available [here](#)

Non-EU/EEC Students

- If you are a student from outside the EU/EEC, you will need to visit the bank in person with the **correct supporting documentation**.
- You will need to book an appointment if you visit the Sligo Town Branch.

AIB – IT Sligo Campus	You can visit the bank during its opening hours. No appointment is required.
AIB – Sligo Town	You must make an appointment by emailing 93725@aib.ie

What documents do I need?

To open a bank account at **AIB** you will need the following documents:

- Passport
- Letter of Registration from IT Sligo confirming your registration status and address in Ireland. You can request this online [here](#).
- IT Sligo Student Card (if available)
